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#### **STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT**

The Charity is a company limited by guarantee and was incorporated on 1 March 2010. The Charity is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association. It is registered as a charity with the Charity Commission. The liability of each member in the event of winding up is limited to £1.

During the year the Trustees make decisions regarding strategic matters. However, the Chief Executive Officer makes decisions regarding the day-to-day running of the Charity.

The Trustees have conducted a review of the major risks to which the Charity is exposed, and systems have been established to mitigate those risks. Internal risks are minimised by the implementation of procedures for authorisation of all transactions and projects and to ensure consistent quality of delivery for all operational aspects of the charitable company. These procedures are periodically reviewed to ensure that they still meet the needs of the Charity.

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

To promote the physical, mental and spiritual wellbeing of the inhabitants of localities across the UK and the world; by, in particular but not exclusively, by the provision of pastoral care and the formation of a Street Angels programme for the benefit of the local community without distinction of race, sex, political, religious or other opinion of the members of such a community.

To support, care for and treat persons in need who are homeless and suffering from the effects of poverty, sickness, disability, old age, alcoholism, drug addiction, offending behaviour, or any other mental or physical infirmity, as an expression of Christian faith.

##### **Chair of Christian Nightlife Initiatives (CNI) Board of Trustees Report**

At last year's AGM we said goodbye to our longstanding trustee and Chair, Steve Brock, who stood down from the board. Steve was an original CNI trustee and had served since 2012. As a trustee, and latterly as the Chair, Steve saw a period of exceptional growth, along with national recognition. He brought vision and focus to the board; we thank him for all that he achieved and wish him well in the future.

The last 12 months have been a time of consolidation for CNI. Our visionary CEO, Paul Blakey MBE, has continued to visit existing projects, meet with new projects, and network with our partners and agencies that help us to achieve all that we have. The growth in work at music festivals has increased the need for Festival Angels and CNI has been involved in an increasing number of projects delivering this essential service. They are spread throughout the UK and look to us for assistance and advice in many areas.

We have for many years been looking at a framework of Regional Coordinators. We have trailed this model in Yorkshire and Humberside, under the direction of our Regional Coordinator, Katie Waters. This model has proved very successful in terms of engagement with projects, and links back to the board of trustees. I would like to thank Katie for all that she has achieved and all her dedicated hard work. We are now looking to expand this model across a number of regions and would value contact from anyone who might be interested in this role. We have strengthened our links with partners in the South West and following a very successful few days for myself and Paul in Cornwall in March, we welcomed 'Pirans Angels' who are based in Newquay into our family.

Finally, I want to thank my fellow trustees, Stuart, Olivia and Ian for their tremendous support and encouragement over the last 12 months. Stuart has been a particular asset as our Vice Chair and has been a constant help to both Paul and myself.

I look forward to the next 12 months and am excited for what lays ahead for us as we continue to serve in our unique ministry.

Many thanks for all within our CNI Network family of local projects who have continued to serve local communities with a heart and vision of #MakingCityStreetsLikeNewAgain!

Over the last 12 months it is great that Jean, Katie (who is the CNI Network regional coordinator for the North) and myself have visited projects, met with volunteers and helped make initiatives such as Festival Angels and regional conference events happen.

We continue to network and partner with a wide range of organisations as we seek to demonstrate God's Kingdom as a reality for others and communities. In November I was one of the keynote speakers at the Christian Police Association conference and this year became a trustee for Redeeming Our Communities - both of whom we partner with on #FaithAndPoliceTogether.

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I report to the trustees on my examination of the financial statements of Street Angels - Christian Nightlife Initiatives ('the charity') for the year ended 31 March 2019.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND BASIS OF REPORT**

As the trustees of the company (and also its directors for the purposes of company law) you are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements in accordance with the requirements of the Companies Act 2006 ('the 2006 Act').

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#### **1. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The charity is a public benefit entity and a private company limited by guarantee, registered in England and Wales and a registered charity in England and Wales. The address of the registered office is The King's Centre, Park Road, Halifax, HX1 1HU.

#### **2. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE**

These financial statements have been prepared in compliance with FRS 102, 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland', the Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (Charities SORP (FRS 102)) and the Companies Act 2006.

#### **3. ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

##### **Basis of preparation**

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis.

The financial statements are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the entity.

##### **Going concern**

There are no material uncertainties about the charity's ability to continue.

##### **Judgements and key sources of estimation uncertainty**

The preparation of the financial statements requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the amounts reported. These estimates and judgements are continually reviewed and are based on experience and other factors, including expectations of future events that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances.

There are not considered to be any judgements or accounting estimates or assumptions that have a significant impact on the financial statements

##### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees to further any of the charity's purposes.

Designated funds are unrestricted funds earmarked by the trustees for particular future project or commitment.

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### 3. ACCOUNTING POLICIES *(continued)*

#### **Incoming resources**

All income is included in the statement of financial activities when entitlement has passed to the charity, it is probable that the economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the charity and the amount can be reliably measured. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income:

- income from donations or grants is recognised when there is evidence of entitlement to the gift, receipt is probable, and its amount can be measured reliably.
- legacy income is recognised when receipt is probable, and entitlement is established.

#### **Resources expended**

Expenditure is recognised on an accruals basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes any VAT which cannot be fully recovered, and is classified under headings of the statement of financial activities to which it relates:

- expenditure on raising funds includes the costs of all fundraising activities and events.
- expenditure on charitable activities includes all costs incurred by a charity in undertaking activities that further its charitable aims for the benefit of its beneficiaries, including those support costs and costs relating to the governance of the charity apportioned to charitable activities.

All costs are allocated to expenditure categories reflecting the use of the resource. Direct costs attributable to a single activity are allocated directly to that activity. Shared costs are apportioned between the activities they contribute to on a reasonable, justifiable and consistent basis.

#### **Financial instruments**

The company only has financial assets and financial liabilities of a kind that qualify as basic financial instruments. Basic financial instruments are initially recognised at transaction value and subsequently measured at their settlement value.

#### **Defined contribution plans**

Contributions to defined contribution plans are recognised as an expense in the period in which the related service is provided. Prepaid contributions are recognised as an asset to the extent that the prepayment will lead to a reduction in future payments or a cash refund.
